### School Finances:

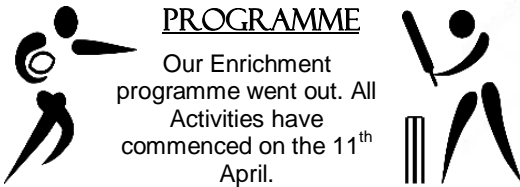
