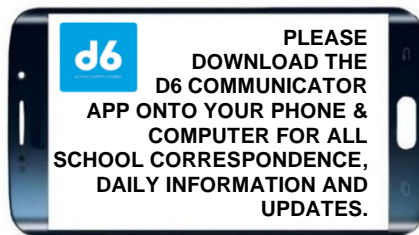

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Summer:

Boys – White short sleeve shirts with badge on pocket, grey pants, grey socks and black shoes.

Please ensure the correct reference is used. The reference number is on the **top right hand** side of the statement, it starts with a "3". Please remember that we may have more than one child in our school with the same surname.
