## SCHOOL UNIFORM



### 2021

Summer or Winter Uniform may be worn from the beginning of Term 2, depending on the weather. A date for full winter school uniform will be communicated via D6.

It is expected that all learners come to school correctly dressed in school uniform this includes a **compulsory** mask. **Boys:** Summer open-necked shirt with a School badge on it, winter long sleeve white shirt with a tie. Grey long or short trousers. These are available from the Office. **Girls** to wear their green summer school dress, winter green pants, white shirt and tie. A green school jersey, blazer or the correct Dri-Mac are the only items of clothing that may be worn if the weather turns cold. **Coloured tops will be confiscated if worn.**

The School Tracksuit may be bought at school. This is not school uniform and should be worn for all sports meetings later in the year. Learners may not wear any jewellery. Gold stud or sleeper earrings may be worn as well as a Medic-Alert bracelet. Hair must be neat at all times. No child may have bleached or coloured hair. No ornate hairstyles are acceptable. Please be aware that the school **cannot be held responsible** for Cell phones that are brought to school.

## COMMUNICATION FILE



A Communication File has been given to every learner from Gr 1 – 7. Parents are requested to check this file every day please. Learners need to bring this file to school daily so that it can be checked. Effective communication and rapport between parents and educators will ensure an atmosphere for our children that is conducive to learning. 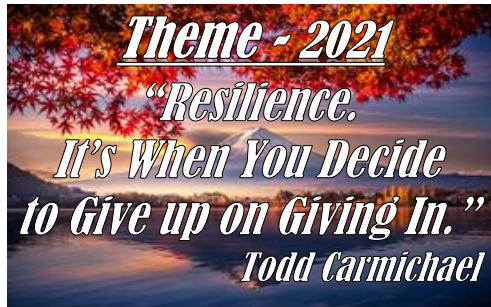
### FREE D6 COMMUNICATOR
