1. Search and select 'd6 Connect'.
  2. Click the 'Install' button.
  3. Click 'Open' once the application is installed.
  4. Click 'Register'.
  5. Fill in the required fields and select the T&Cs to continue.
  6. A message will appear stating that a One Time Pin (OTP) has been sent via SMS to the device being registered.
  7. Click 'OK' to continue.
  8. Enter the OTP and 'Submit'.

## SCHOOL UNIFORM

Learners may start wearing Summer Uniform from the 1<sup>st</sup> of September. All learners are to be in full Summer Uniform by the 1<sup>st</sup> of October. It is expected that all learners come to school correctly dressed in school uniform this includes a **compulsory** mask. **Boys:** Winter long sleeve white shirt with a tie. Grey long trousers. **Girls:** to wear their winter green pants, white shirt and tie. A green school jersey, blazer or the correct Dri-Mac are the only items of clothing that may be worn if the weather turns cold. **Coloured tops will be confiscated if worn.** The School Tracksuit may be bought at school. This is **not** school uniform and is only worn for all sports meetings. Learners may not wear any jewellery. Gold stud or sleeper earrings may be worn as well as a Medic-Alert bracelet. Hair must be neat at all times. No child may have bleached or coloured hair. No ornate hairstyles are acceptable. Please be aware that the school **cannot be held responsible** for cell phones that are brought to school.

## PUNCTUALITY

The school day begins at **07:40**. Learners must arrive between 07:00 - 07:30, as to facilitate the social distancing and screening process before entering their classes. Many parents and transport drivers drop children after the school bell has rung. This is unfair to your child and to the school. We request that combi's transporting learners to and from school utilise the car park on the corner of Charterland and Itogen Roads. Please be aware that Molyneux Ave is a **ONE WAY** in the mornings and afternoons. Please **DO NOT** park in front of the school gate. Learners are to be collected as soon as the school bell rings. This is for the safety of all Learners and Teachers.



## COMMUNICATION FILE

Parents are requested to please check the communication file every day. Please note that no visitors are allowed into the school during this time.
