SCHOOL UNIFORM 2022



Learners may come to school in either Summer or Winter school uniform, all learners should be in full winter uniform by the 3rd May 2022. This includes a **compulsory** mask. If boys wear the open-necked shirt it must have a badge on it, otherwise the school **tie must be worn**. These are available from the office. Girls wear their green school dress. A green school jersey, blazer or the correct Dri-Mac are the only items of clothing that may be worn if the weather turns cold. **Coloured tops will be confiscated if worn**. The school tracksuit may be bought at school. This is not school uniform and should be worn for all sports meetings later in the year. Learners may not wear any jewellery. Gold studs or sleeper earrings may be worn as well as a Medic-Alert bracelet. Hair must be neat at all times. No child may have bleached or coloured hair. No ornate hairstyles are acceptable. Please be aware that the school **cannot be held responsible** for cell phones that are brought to school.



Safety and security for all Learners is of utmost importance to us at Selcourt Primary. Please make sure your child arrives at School with a mask, as well as an extra mask in case of damage or loss. Please also ensure learners are picked up from school on time and not left outside the school unattended. Please note lunch or any other school items will not be accepted at the office to hand out to learners.
